he Vincent HoSang Family Foundation (VHFF), celebrated its 10th Anniversary and Community Awards Benefit Gala on June 13, 2014, at the Astoria World Manor in Astoria. Queens, with scores of community leaders. friends and well-wishers including Jamaica's Consul General to New York, Herman G. LaMont, Jamaica's Minister of Health, Dr. Fenton Ferguson, CD, New York Assemblyman, Nick Perry and Chairman of LASCO Jamaica Limited, Honorable Lascelles Chin, OD.

The illustrious event recognized and honored three community service groups for their outstanding work to humanity. The Duncan Tree Foundation for its exemplary contributions in improving health and wellness needs to the underserved in the US, in Jamaica and the Philippines, Voice of the Children of Haiti, whose mission is in response to the cries of that country's poorest and homeless children and People to People, a Rockland County based food pantry operation that assists struggling residents in difficult times.

The evening's Guest Speaker, Mr. Lascelles Chin lauded the VHFF for its outstanding philanthropic contributions to local communities and the Caribbean. "Giving back is one of the most significant attributes of any business organization as it speaks volumes of the principals," he said. "The HoSangs spirit of giving is unique and a model for many to emulate." The business leader implored the audience to continue to support the HoSangs' businesses and by extension, the VHFF.

Jamaica's Health Minister, Dr. Ferguson also, had high praises for the VHFF's tremendous impact on communities and individuals it comes in contact with. The minister used the occasion to highlight the partnership between the VHFF and his ministry. "The Ministry of Health is keen on partnerships such as these as we need your support to move forward with plans to develop the health sector," he said. One such plan afoot is the VHFF's cancer care venture - The Jamaica LINAC Machine Project Initiative, a call-to-action to assist with the acquisition of two Linear Accelerator radiation machines to the tune of US\$5 million dollars. The minister said, the VHFF's focus this year is in keeping with the goals of his ministry to provide the equipment and tools necessary to improve Jamaica's cancer care program. "The ministry is desirous of acquiring these machines as well and we are happy to have your support in this venture," Dr. Ferguson said.

Chairman of the VHFF, Vincent HoSang in his response said, he was greatly moved and was extremely thankful for the support of the community. "I was born to serve with humility and I believe this is God's plan for my life," he said.


